### **Sarasota County Utilities responds to site of sewage spill on Siesta Key**

Sarasota County Utilities crews are working to repair a sewage force main break that occurred Monday afternoon at 6415 Midnight Pass Road on Siesta Key. The spill is less than 500 gallons. Crews are on site and have contained the spill. Sarasota County Utilities crews are working to replace the damaged pipe and vacuum the site. Samples will be pulled on a daily basis until coliform bacterial counts return to normal.

All state agencies have been notified, and signs posted by the Sarasota County Department of Health will remain in place until water samples return to acceptable levels.
