It's time to clean out the garage and gather up yard waste. Sarasota County will hold its annual community cleanup in the Laurel area from 8 a.m.-3 p.m. Saturday, April 17. Dumpsters will be provided by Waste Management and will be available at two locations to receive materials from residents.

The locations are:

- Forest Street at Laurel Park
- 504 Collins Street (opposite the Sandra Sims Terry Recreation Center)

Residents can dispose of most appliances, household items, scrap materials, unbundled yard waste and other materials during this free event. Paint, pesticides, auto parts, televisions, computers and other hazardous materials cannot be accepted.

Sarasota County employees will be available at each site to offer assistance.
