Laurel community cleanup will be Sept. 18

It's time to clean out the garage and gather up yard waste. Sarasota County will hold its annual community cleanup in the Laurel area from 8 a.m.-3 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 18. Dumpsters will be provided by Waste Management and will be available at two locations for materials from residents.

The locations are:

- Forest Street at Laurel Park
- 504 Collins Street, across from Laurel Park and the Sandra Sims Terry Community Center

Residents can dispose of most appliances, household items, scrap materials, unbundled yard waste and other materials during this free event. Paint, pesticides, auto parts, televisions, computers and other hazardous materials won't be accepted.

Sarasota County employees will be available at each site to offer assistance.

Hazardous waste may be taken to the Sarasota County Chemical Collection Center, 8750 Bee Ridge Road, Sarasota, from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Wednesday-Saturday. The collection center is near Rothenbach Park.
