Law Library moves to Selby Library, sets hours

The Sarasota County Law Library, at 2050 Adams Lane, Sarasota, will be packed up at the close of business on Friday, Oct 15. A core collection of essential materials will be provided at a temporary location at Selby Public Library, 1331 First Street, Sarasota on the second floor. The most frequently used online database, Westlaw, will be available.

The Law Library will re-open at 10 a.m., Monday, Oct. 18. The law librarian at Selby will be available from 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10 a.m.-noon on Saturdays.

The collection is being reviewed to determine the most popular and needed items, following the recommendations of the Stetson Law School and law library expert Nora Everlove. A permanent location for the Law Library has not been determined.

Additional law library resources are available in south Sarasota County on the second floor of the Robert L. Anderson Government Center, 4000 South Tamiami Trail, and Venice and in Manatee County at the Manatee County Judicial Center, 1051 Manatee Ave., West, Bradenton.
