Free seminar offers tips to avoid home foreclosure

Sarasota county homeowners who need help with foreclosures, bankruptcy, credit problems or home ownership opportunities can attend a free “Hope for Homeowners” seminar.

When: 6-7:30 p.m., Tuesday, Nov. 30

Where: Venice Library, 300 S. Nokomis Ave., Venice

Chief Judge Lee Haworth will lead a discussion of panelists who will talk about what homeowners can do to avoid foreclosure and the legal options they have. Residents will be able to ask questions and talk with financial and legal experts.

Sarasota County and the Community Alliance of Sarasota County are organizing the seminar.
